Dear Friends,

A vital nonprofit sector is essential to our region, especially during such tough economic times. Since 1993, BVU has provided high impact services that link businesses to nonprofits, strengthen the governance and leadership capacity of our region's nonprofit sector, and engage thousands of volunteers in meaningful service.

As we celebrate 15 years, it is important to recognize the founding vision behind BVU. Our founders sought to create a vehicle to engage the next generation of business leaders on nonprofit boards. Fifteen years later, this vision is a reality, and BVU has not only achieved this original mission but continues to be creative in finding solutions to increase the number and diversity of the candidates in our board matching pipeline.

Looking forward, we see nonprofit leaders facing mounting and complex challenges. We see the demand for our services at an all time high. Working to meet this increasing demand, BVU raised our service levels across the board in 2008, with no increase in staff. Examples of successful initiatives we developed include:

Nonprofit Consulting Center – Consolidating BVU's existing consulting services under this umbrella program to provide nonprofit board and staff leadership with easy access to BVU's high value consulting, including board development, succession planning and volunteer consulting.


Management and Functional Consulting – Building a volunteer consulting program designed to engage skilled volunteers (business professionals and retirees) in providing substantial consulting services to nonprofits in Northeast Ohio. In 2009, BVU will continue to expand this program to provide critical assistance to nonprofits to help them address management issues. We are making it easy for our clients to access important expertise to deal with their concerns and opportunities.

Diversity Initiative – Training and matching minority professionals to nonprofit boards, and engaging young professionals with nonprofits. BVU will hold at least three events in 2009 to attract these underrepresented populations to board service.


Financial Management Series – Presenting seminars focusing on key aspects of financial management is an example of how BVU consistently changes the content of seminars based on the needs of our community. Each of the 3 seminars offered in this 2008 series sold out weeks in advance. BVU continues to develop responsive seminars in 2009, including a series designed to help nonprofits navigate through challenging times.

Volunteer Center – Upgrading volunteer referral services by leveraging the proven national resource Volunteer Solutions to offer a new interface for our users. This technology allows nonprofits to recruit and manage direct service volunteers online and individuals to conduct searches with greater accuracy. The new BVU Volunteer Center launched April 2009. Check it out!

As we celebrate our accomplishments, and look to the future, we recognize our key partners and stakeholders who make our mission possible. We thank our foundation funders, business members, United Way Services of Greater Cleveland, and nonprofit members. 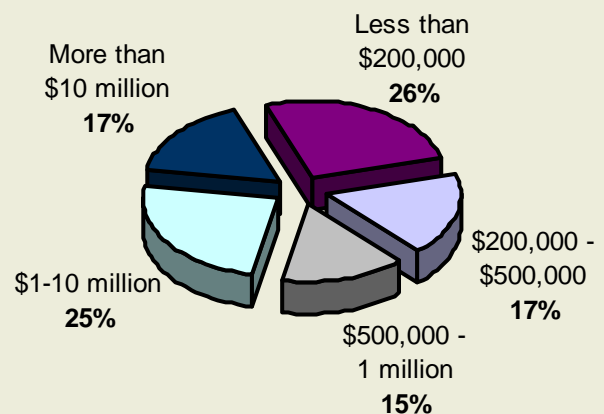

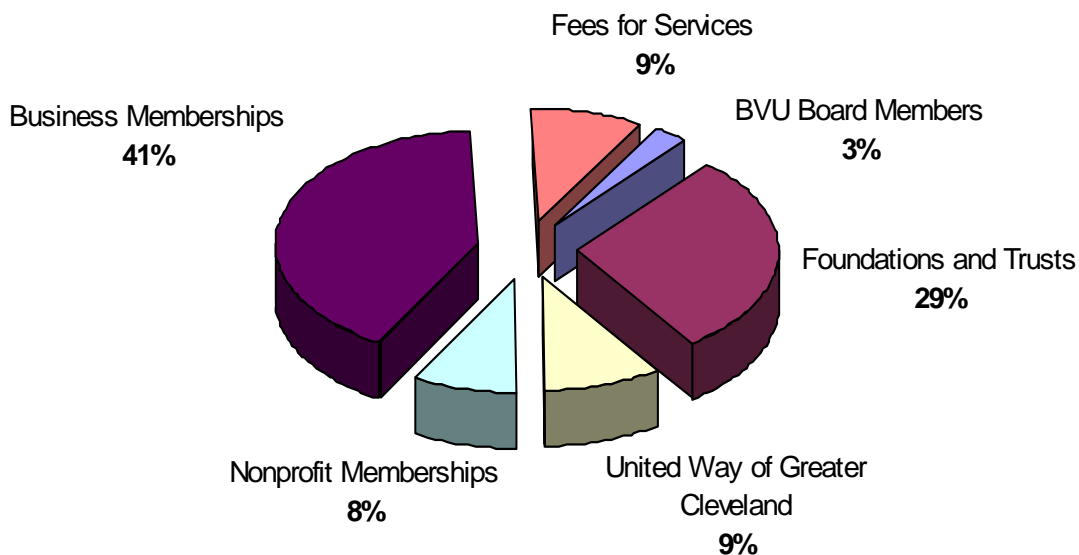
