Letter from the Board Chair and President & CEO

Dear Friends

Needless to say, 2009 was a challenging year for all of us. From BVU's unique vantage point at the intersection of businesses, nonprofits and volunteers, we witnessed tremendous determination, innovation and generosity.

By November 2008, as the financial crisis heightened, we were concerned that philanthropy and volunteerism would take a back seat, and that support for BVU would suffer as a result. Throughout 2009 BVU staff met with over 200 nonprofit leaders, 90+ business members and each of our sixteen foundation funders to learn more about their needs and priorities, and ensure that BVU's services were aligned to meet their changing needs.

The feedback was that BVU's services were needed now more than ever. Despite our concerns, BVU's 140+ business members continued to facilitate employee volunteerism, and over 83% maintained their level of philanthropy to the community from the prior year. This demonstrates the unique commitment of NEO businesses to our community despite their own internal cost cutting and belt tightening initiatives. BVU also saw a significant increase in demand from nonprofits for board members, volunteer consultants, and consulting to strengthen their management and governance. BVU's foundation funders maintained their support because they view BVU as a partner in strengthening the capacity of the community's nonprofits. These factors contributed to BVU providing historic levels of support, without increasing our own capacity, to meet the community's needs in 2009. Highlights include:

- Board matches increased over 50% in 2009 to 248 elections. This is an all time high for our flagship program.
- BVU's Nonprofit Consulting Center provided 114 consultations including 52 governance consultations and succession plans by BVU staff, and over 60 volunteer consultations in the areas of technology, marketing, HR and financial operations.
- BVU's Volunteer Center online traffic increased over 140% to almost 12,000 individuals searching over 400 volunteer opportunities.

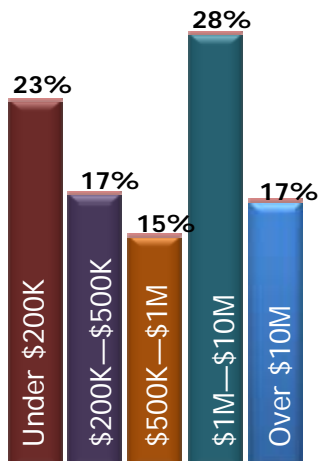

141 BVU business members build strong connections throughout the NEO community

- **Connected as leaders on nonprofit boards** -- 248 business professionals elected to nonprofit boards of directors through BVU's board matching program. Businesses leverage board matching to facilitate leadership development and community connections for employees.
- **Connected as volunteer consultants** -- 53 business professionals and retirees engaged to provide 76 volunteer management and operational consulting projects to nonprofits. Professionals appreciate the opportunity to volunteer their time and expertise to assist nonprofits with challenging business projects.
- **Connected through team-building volunteer projects** -- 95 "Done-in-a-Day" volunteer projects where teams of employees worked together to accomplish high impact projects.

804 nonprofits leverage BVU to strengthen their capacity and engage volunteers

- **Utilized governance and management capacity building services** – 630 nonprofits accessed BVU's capacity building consulting and training, including board development, succession planning and management assistance.
- **Accessed thought leadership and training** – 1,103 individuals attended 27 BVU's seminars (attendees included nonprofit executives, board members and business and community leaders).
- **Engaged board members and volunteer consultants-** 158 nonprofits were connected to highly qualified business professionals who use their talents to address complex governance and organizational issues.
- **Recruited volunteers** - 11,938 individuals searched over 400 volunteer opportunities at 194 area nonprofits, benefitting the individuals who volunteered, the nonprofits they served and the community as a whole.

BVU is grateful for significant support from the foundation community. BVU leverages these foundation dollars to strengthen the capacity of nonprofit organizations with governance and organizational consulting, training and volunteer referral services.

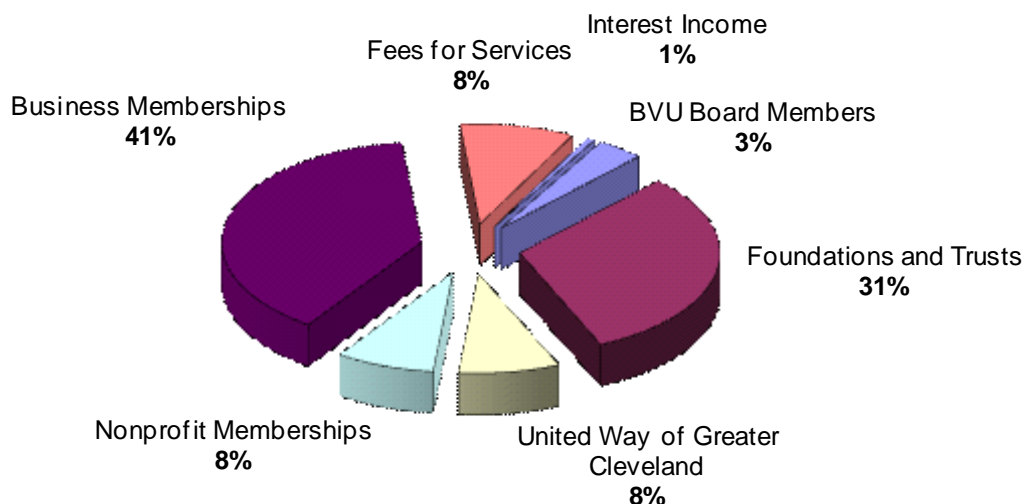
